



# Concealed Carry Pistol - Intermediate

## Duration

2 Days / 16 Hours

## Course Overview

Obtain a solid foundation of defensive handgun skills and techniques for concealed carry and personal defense in this course. This class is for individuals who intend to carry a concealed defensive pistol and are seeking handgun skills for self-defense in their everyday environment. This course will meet the training requirements for a CCW in the State of Maryland and the Commonwealth of Virginia. It may also fulfill requirements of other states and jurisdictions for obtaining various resident and non-resident handgun permits. \*\*\* It is recommended that the student check laws in their state for clarification \*\*\*

## Prerequisites

Minimum skill level required: Intermediate

## What You Need to Bring

- 300 rounds of factory ammunition is required.

- Semi-Auto Pistol in one of the following calibers: .380, 9mm NATO, .357 SIG, .40 S&W, or .45 ACP (no other calibers allowed)
- 3 magazines minimum
- Belt mounted, dominant side concealment holster (all students will be required to wear a waist level, belt mounted, dominant side holster for this course)
- Magazine Pouches
- Sturdy Belt at least 1.5" wide
- Footwear suitable for rapid movement and turning.
- Clothing suitable for training in any weather. Pants must have belt loops.
- Hat with a brim
- Wraparound eyewear
- Earmuffs and earplugs
