

COURSE OVERVIEW

The National Rifle Association (NRA) Basic Shotgun course is designed to teach students about the safe handling, shooting fundamentals, shooting positions, and other applications of the shotgun.

This is a hands-on course, ideal for those who are new to shotguns and would like to learn about their proper handling and use.
